In the afternoon, our focus will be on Reading Comprehension as this is our identified SMART Goals (see below) for this year. Following a review and discussion of our 2015/16 school collected data, we will be focusing on our individual classroom efforts to increase student Reading Comprehension levels. We will also be presenting all the new reading resources which have been purchased by the school to support our goal. So far this year we have purchased over \$3000 of resources for staff.

### **ERES 2015 / 2016 SMART Goals**

#### **Language Arts**

The 2016 English ELA reading results will demonstrate an increase in students reading comprehension for Fiction and Non Fiction reading with emphasis on the Literacy Strategies – Self Monitoring, Analyzing, Sequencing, Making Connections, Predicting Evaluative, Inferring, Synthesizing – In doing so, we hope to increase our achievement level from 75% to 82% with a focus on increasing achievement with emphasis on the Literacy Strategies for Reading.

The 2015 FI ELA reading results will demonstrate an increase in students reading comprehension for Fiction and Non Fiction reading with emphasis on the Literacy Strategies – Self Monitoring, Analyzing, Sequencing, Making Connections, Predicting Evaluative, Inferring, Synthesizing- in doing so, we hope to increase our achievement level from 60% to 66% with a focus on increasing achievement with emphasis on the Literacy Strategies for Reading.

#### **Math**

Students (excluding those on IEP and modified programs) will attain mastery of 85% in basic operations within three seconds: multiplication and division in grades 4 – 6.
